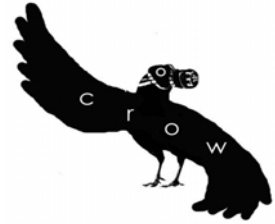

## We have been heard!

The Standing Policy Committee on Protection and Community Services today passed Motion 580 to review the effectiveness of fogging (moved by Donald Benham--thank you, thank you!) and voted to lay over Motion 579 to suspend buffer zones (moved by John Angus). As Donald Benham explained in his opening remarks, should a complete review of Malathion find that further fogging is not warranted, the other motion will be moot.

Minister of Conservation, Stan Struthers, has indicated in meetings with us and to media that his department will be conducting some type of review of the Pesticide Use Permit process before next mosquito season.

## CROW members want to get organized!

Structure and committee selection will be the focus of a meeting this coming Monday. Once committees have been developed, an invitation will be extended to everyone wishing to get involved in developing proactive mosquito control alternatives for next summer (did I hear bat house building committee?) Stay tuned for more details...

The Province of Manitoba has ended routine mosquito trapping in its West Nile virus surveillance program and advises that the risk of contracting WNV is very low at this point in the year.
